- 4 Easy rides will continue through winter.
- 5 In Spring, we could make a real push to encourage novices.
- 6 Designated family rides are worth running a few times a year.
- 7 The website image and content should make clear that some rides will suit novices.
- 8 Pedal Power bike hire could be advertised on the site.
- 9 A poster at our regular start point may help publicize the rides.
- 10 New ride leaders would be welcomed.

#### **Meetings**

- 11 Addressing meeting room cost is a priority, although we all seem to like Chapter.
- 12 Monthly meetings at Chapter could switch to bi-monthly, and would could organize other types of events at other venues.

#### **Organization**

- 13 We need more signatories to the bank account. Alastair has volunteered to keep financial records.
- 14 We **do** need to adopt a constitution in November.
- 15 We **don't** want formal procedural meetings.

#### **Other objectives**

- 16 We'll lobby the council to run Bikes in the City (ITWMC) next year.
- 17 We'll continue with Bike Week and information stalls next year.
- 18 We'll make a plans to appeal beyond our current member profile.
